This program is intended to provide guidance in what to do, and not do, as a bystander. The goal is to bridge the gap between the event and when professional “first responders” arrive.

PROGRAM CONTENT

What can be done immediately?

- + Situation assessment and calling for help
- + Basic First Aid & the First Aid Kit
- + Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)
- + Automatic External Defibrillator (AED)
- + “Stop—the—Bleed”
- + Avulsed Tooth Re-implantation
- + Choking
- + Allergic Reactions

All participants will be encouraged to apply the content in a hands-on format using the manikins and other teaching aids provided. There will be numerous opportunities to ask questions and get feedback on your performance.
